



## SAMPLE WORDING FOR WILLS

There are a number of ways to include a gift to the Vancouver Community College Foundation through your estate plans and will. Below are some suggested clauses to consider in your planning:

### Unrestricted Bequests

#### A Percentage (also known as Residual) Gift Amount

“I give \_\_\_\_\_% of the residue of my estate to the Vancouver Community College Foundation for its general purposes.”

#### A Specific Gift Amount

“I give the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ to the Vancouver Community College Foundation for its general purposes.”

### Restricted Bequests

I give the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ dollars to the Vancouver Community College Foundation for the benefit of \_\_\_\_\_ (department, program, project or award). If circumstances make the specified use of this bequest impractical or undesirable, the Board of Directors of the Vancouver Community College Foundation is authorized to apply the gift to other purposes that conform as much as possible to the spirit and intent of my original wishes.

### Including a Gift for with a Naming provision

I give the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ dollars to the Vancouver Community College Foundation to establish a fund to be known as (Name of the Testator or another for whom the endowment will be named) Fund (the “Fund”).
