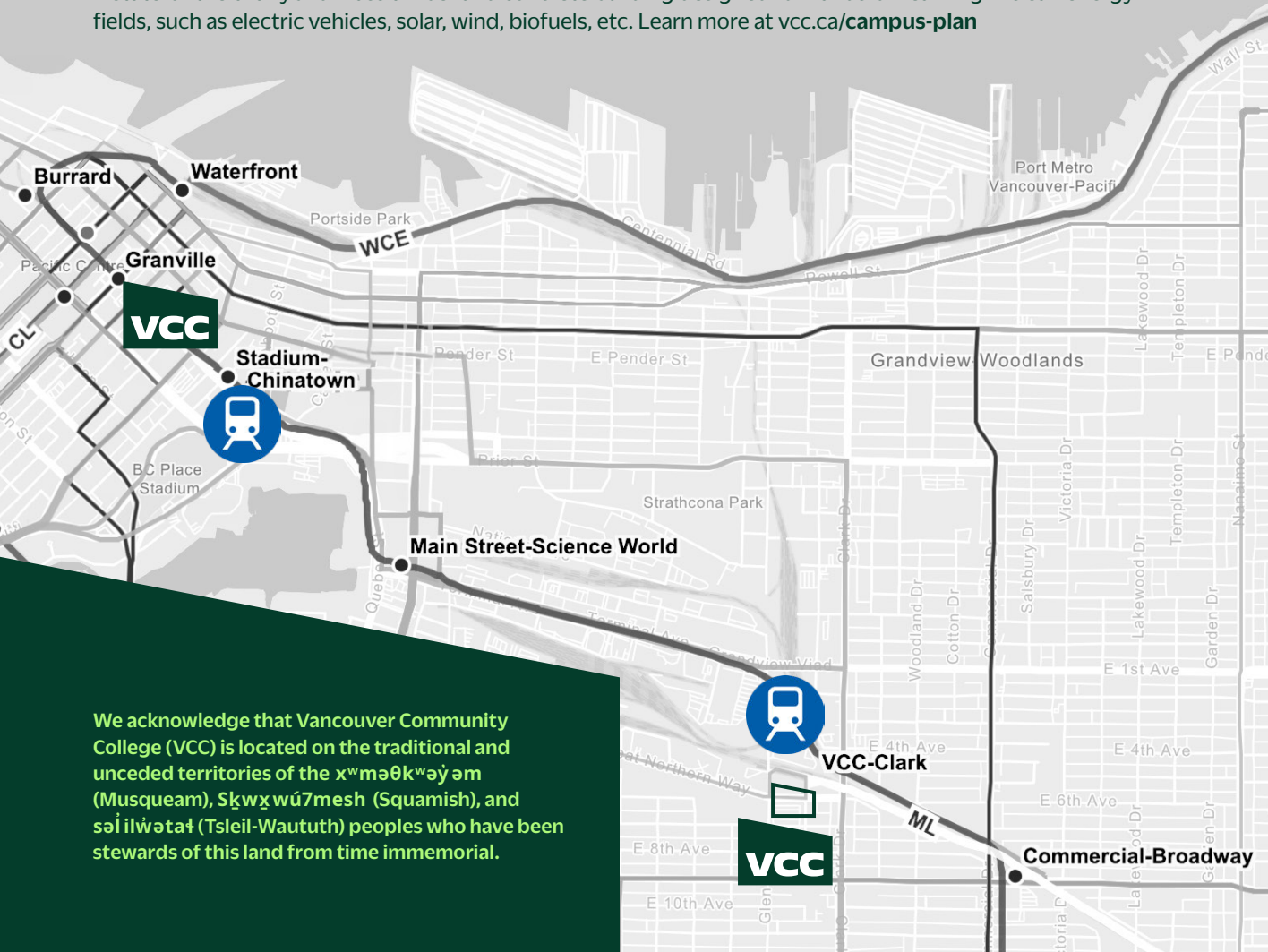

A non-refundable \$36 application fee is required for domestic students (subject to change). For most programs, you will be directed to EducationPlannerBC.

Submit supporting documents

Official transcripts

Original documents only. Documents not in English or French must be translated by a certified translation service.

Provincial Education Number (PEN)

If applicable. PEN is issued to every Kindergarten to Grade 12 student in British Columbia.

Copy of Permanent Resident Card

If applicable. Required from Permanent Resident students.

Educational Credential Assessment (ECA) report

If applicable. Applicants with educational documents not from Canadian or American institutions may be required to submit an educational credential assessment.

Proof of English language proficiency

For all applicants. To check requirements, visit vcc.ca/elp.
